SUBJECT: DISCUSSION/APPROVAL- BOARD POLICY/ADMINISTRATIVE
REGULATIONS 1330 ON FACILITIES USE

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Education review, possibly revise and approve additions made to Administrative Regulations 1330.

BACKGROUND

In August 2005, the Coastal Commission heard the District's request for a Coastal Permit to begin new construction at Hermosa Valley School. The District was granted a preliminary permit. The District was requested by the Commission to give alternatives to alleviate parking overflow when the new facility may be used by groups after school hours whose size may exceed the number of school parking spaces available.

Included in the Administrative Regulations 1330, is new language which addresses the Coastal Commission concern on parking.
