Hermosa Beach Submits School Building Plans

The Hermosa Beach city school district has adopted a program for rehabilitating and strengthening the Pier-avenue school at Hermosa Beach, it was announced yesterday. Recommendations have been forwarded to the Board of Public Building Reconstruction at Sacramento for approval.

It is planned to demolish the auditorium portion of the old building, rehabilitate and strengthen the classroom portion and construct a two-classroom addition on the east end of the structure, which would provide a total of twelve classrooms. Preliminary plans provide for reinforced concrete exterior walls. A new reinforced concrete auditorium to seat approximately 750 persons also is planned. The cost is estimated at \$73,000.

Samuel E. Lunden is the architect and Paul E. Jeffers is the structural engineer for the project.
