Dear Mr. Muegenburg:

You requested certain information on behalf of the unification committee regarding district property. We are herewith transmitting that information to you.

Hermosa Beach City School District has six schools and other facilities as follows:

1. Hermosa View, 1800 Prospect Avenue, is a K-6 school. It has ten regular classrooms, one deaf classroom, an administrative unit, and a completed play area. It has 9,841 sq. ft. of classroom space on a 7.5 acre site. The last calendar month's enrollment was 329.
2. North, 417 - 25th Street, is a K-6 school. It has 13 regular classrooms, one multi-use room, an administrative unit, and a complete play area. It has 11,744 sq. ft. of classroom space on a 6.2 acre site. The last calendar month's enrollment was 383.
3. Pier Avenue, 710 Pier Avenue, is a 7-8 school. It has 15 regular classrooms, one multi-use room, one shop, one homemaking room, one gym, and a complete administrative unit. In addition, there is a 500 seat auditorium at this site. It has 19,948 sq. ft. of classroom space, excluding the auditorium, on a 5.7 acre site. Also located here is the district maintenance facility, consisting of three old houses, plus adjacent ground, and a mechanic's garage, on the school grounds proper. The last calendar month's enrollment was 447.
4. Prospect Heights, 425 Hollowell Avenue, is a K-4 school. It has five regular classrooms and a multi-use room which is being used as a classroom, plus a complete administrative unit and a completed play area. It has 6,370 sq. ft. being used as classrooms on a 1.6 acre site. The last calendar month's enrollment was 173. In this neighborhood at 1106 - 6th Street is the district supply warehouse where instructional and operational stores are kept in an old two room school and its yard.
